- **NSS Dashain Tihar Celebration
November 5th, 2022**

Previous BOD recognized, event had 36 performers, 35+ volunteers, 450+ attendees supported by NSS Youth, Nepali School. Local performers displayed community spirit. Event included curry & kabab, DJ, and a video montage.

- **NSS Nepali New Year 2080 | April 29th, 2023**

Special guest Himalayan Hendaix, 50+ performers, 50+ volunteers, and 450+ attendees were supported by NSS Youth, Nepali School, NW Tamu Society, and NOA. Community updates on NSS and Community Building were shared, with food provided by Curry and Kebab.





• **NW Jamghat Picnic | September 3rd, 2023**

The biggest event as of yet with over 7 sponsors and over 900 attendees including those from Portland and Vancouver featured the creation of an annual magazine, dance performances, bingo, DJ, Kids activities and sports. Volunteers prepared lunch and dinner, while community booths, kids' activities, and over 50 volunteers enriched the event. Some volunteer individuals sponsored food. Cultural performances were showcased by NW Tamu Society, Newah Organization Association, FAGOW, NW Sherpa Association.

• **NSS Deusi Bhailo Program | November 28th, 2023**

NSS creatively celebrated Dashain and Tihar by visiting specific houses to showcase traditional deusi bhailo with 10 hosts in 4 houses and 29+ performers from the NSS youth and cultural committee and Nepali school.

NEPALI SCHOOL COMMITTEE

Goal: Dedication to cultural preservation and educational enrichment within the community.



Seattle Nepali School History:

- Established in 2010 (February to April), Seattle Nepali School offers Nepali language classes, dance, drama, IT education, and cultural events like Holi. It serves as a platform for young adults to develop leadership skills.

South Seattle Nepali School History:

- Established in 2018 (September to June) offering dance, martial arts, yoga, and participating in Nepali festivals like Dashain, Tihar, and Saraswati Puja. Outdoor activities like picnics and zoo visits enrich students' learning experience with practical exposure to Nepali culture.

SPORTS COMMITTEE

Goal: Promote physical and mental health of our community members



- **NSS First Ever FIFA (online) Gaming November 20th, 2022**

32 participants played online games, including those outside the state and country. Many youth joined NSS, bringing in funds through memberships and collaborating with the membership team.

- **NSS Ping Pong Tournament
January 28th, 2023**

26 people participated in an event at the UW Recreation Center, successfully attracting over 100 people, particularly youths and students from the Seattle area.



- **NSS Youth Annual Soccer Camp 2023
June 11th– August 27th, 2023**

Partnered with Nepal Seattle Football Club from June to September since 2021. Involved 64 kids in 2021, 84 kids in 2022, and 120 kids in 2023. Held camps in Kent and Woodinville in 2023 to reach children from various areas. Appreciation to Seattle FC players, volunteer coaches, and parents for their support.

- **Annual Nepali New Year Cup
April 8th & 9th, 2023**

10 teams participated in the event, with 2 teams from California, 2 from Texas, and 1 from Idaho, representing Washington globally. The event had over 500 attendees, providing a chance to boost membership.



- **Annual Dashain Cup | October 9, 2022**

Partnered with Nepal Seattle FC, a non-profit organization, for a sports event with 10 teams including Portland and Spokane. The event aimed to foster friendship between neighboring states, with over 300 attendees. Vaccination awareness was promoted in collaboration with NSS Health Team. In 2023, 12 teams from Washington state participated.

- **Jamghat Picnic 2022 and 2023**

Included sports representation from Seattle in Vancouver, Canada, with gold medal wins. In 2023, successful sporting events like soccer, volleyball, men's basketball, and youth soccer were organized. The youth soccer tournament was particularly significant, highlighting the importance of involving youths in societal events.

HEALTH COMMITTEE

Goal: Promote healthy lifestyle and health related information to the community

NSS initiated health projects during the onset of the COVID-19 Pandemic in 2020 in collaboration with CDC and DOH WA.

Recent Achievements:

- Conducted a COVID-19 Vaccine camp at Sanatan Dharma Mandir, Kent, on Feb 3rd, 2024
- Provided numerous online COVID-19 disease awareness and vaccination initiatives
- Implemented the PLU DNP Project involving diet and lifestyle intervention
 - By Pramoj Adhikari, FNP-C, DNP, RN, US Army Veteran
 - Mentored by Dr. Nitin Thapa

Future Plans for 2024 and beyond:

- Launching the PLU DNP Project Diabetes and Hypertension Screening Project led by Pramoj Adhikari, DNP
- Organizing community Diabetes and Hypertension screening by Dr. Nitin Thapa
- Hosting a Community Health resources and Medical Insurance information session by Dr. Nitin Thapa



CDCF YEAR 2 PROJECT DETAILS



- **NEYPVAL Project Year 2 | September 23rd, 2022**

Accepted proposal for extension and hired 6 new contractors for Partnering for Vaccine Equity CDCF Year 2 project, selected 6 advisory board members, and 6 community ambassadors. They helped create different social media posts in English and Nepali to provide health informations.

- **Dashain Cup 2022 | October 2nd, 2022**

Refreshments, hand sanitizers, and informational flyers about health were distributed at a tournament by the CDCF year 2 team to gather community health data. They organized engaging activities like polls, photo centers, and kite flying, incorporating messages about flu and COVID on the kites. Collected 53 surveys during the event.





• Survey Results–COVID and Flu

During the Dashain Cup event, 53 surveys were collected, revealing:

- 58.5% believe some are unvaccinated due to flu immunity belief
- 64.2% did not receive a flu shot, but 71.7% are willing to get one, and 88.7% knew what a flu shot is
- 79.2% received a COVID booster
- Common diseases reported were diabetes and heart disease.

• Webinars:

Health Team launched two webinars:

- October 23, 2022: Led by Dr. Nitin Thapa, Dr. Diwakar Thapa, and Jagadamba Adhikaree. Discussed flu, COVID-19 symptoms, resources, and boosters. Interactive session with community questions.
- November 25, 2022: Conducted by Shraddha Kakshapati, Soniya Kunwar, and Jagadamba Adhikaree. Covered COVID, flu, and Triple Burden Disease (RSV, flu, COVID) in kids and adults.

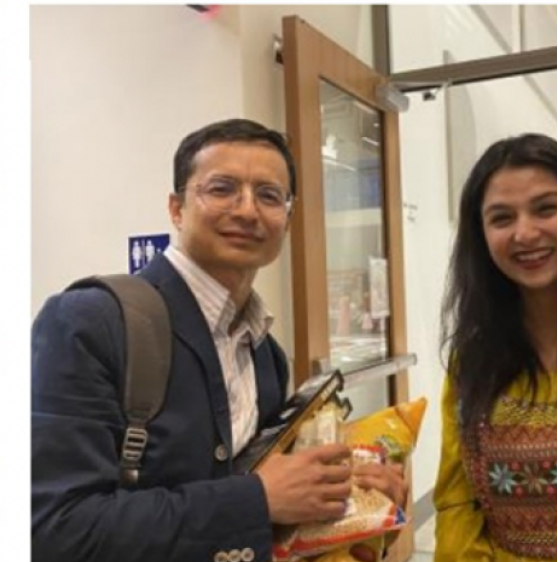


• Podcast

• Community Partnership Events:

October 26th, 2022, the Nepal Seattle Society collaborated with the Newah Organization of America (NOA), distributing goods and collecting surveys.



On November 5th, 2022, during the NSS Dashain Tihar Booth, informational flyers on vaccines and insurance were shared, and 36 surveys were collected to understand vaccine hesitancy in the Nepali community.





• CDCF Year One Project Article Published

CDC Foundation published a story on March 15, 2022 about our Nepali Elder-guided Youth Partnership Vaccination Accessibility Liaison (NEYPVAL) team's efforts. Our partnership with CDCF has helped us build a networking infrastructure in our community and also put our organization in the spotlight at the Federal level. This is a huge milestone for a non-profit organization like us and we couldn't have done this without the help of our advisors and volunteers. If you would like to read the article, you can scan!



• Podcast Article Published

On December 13th, 2023, the CDCF's Partnering for Vaccine Equity Resource Hub released a new article featuring our podcast Let's Talk #KURA ("Let's have a conversation") calling it "Podcasting for Public Health." The article emphasized the unique aspect of this youth-led initiative, the launch of this Nepali-language podcast which premiered in November 2021. 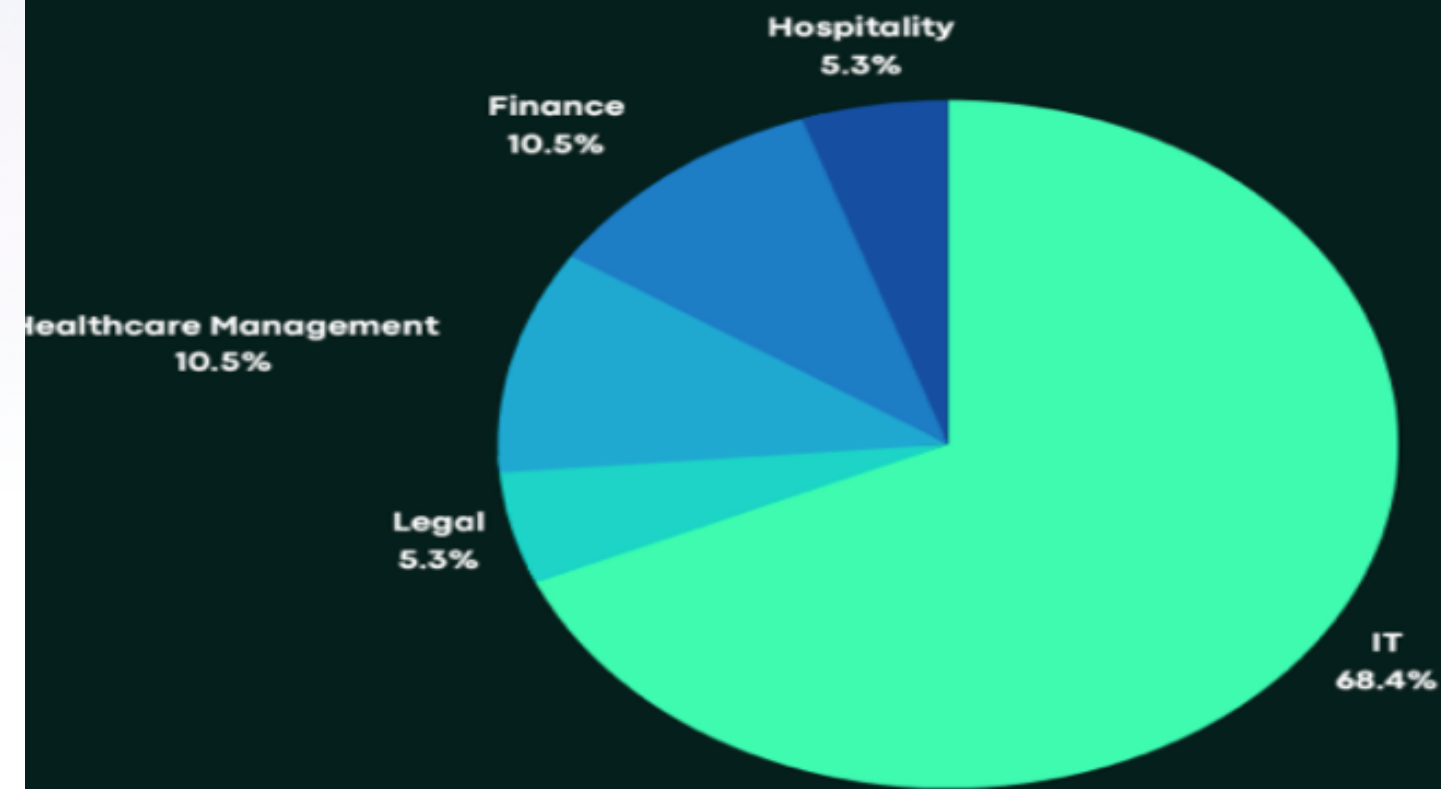

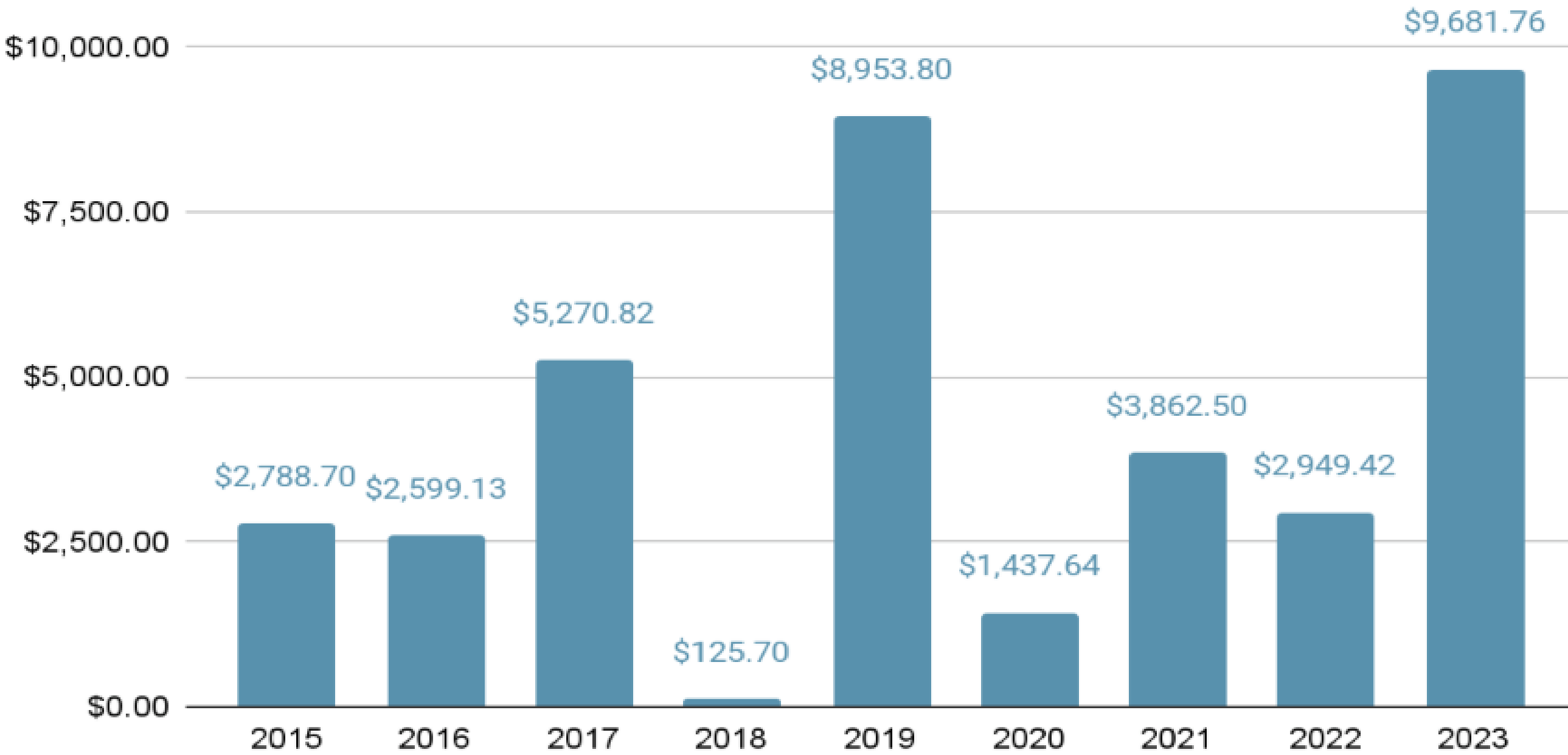

- Income: \$154,831.44
 - Donations : \$42,385.98 (includes both Nepali School donations)
 - Membership: \$1,983.07
 - All other Income: \$36,620.64
 - Grant/Award: \$50,000 (unrestricted, directly funnelled into General Fund)
 - Grant: 23,956.00 (restricted*)

NSS 2023 Financial Overview cont. (Internal Transfers)

- **\$3,460.39 from General Fund to NW Jamghat Fund**
 - BODs decided to bring the NW Jamghat Fund Balance to Zero from the balance reflected at the end of 03/31/2023 for easy tracking of the revenue.
- **\$2,000 from General Fund to South Seattle Nepali School**
 - Non-existent Account Receivable for \$2,000 entered in 2018
 - Scheduled for 2024, BOD approval received in 2023
